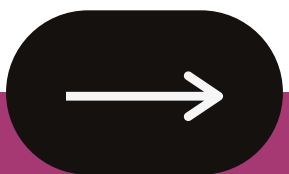

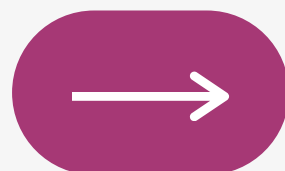

The Need for Capacity

Organizational & Community Equity

Historic disinvestment has included a lack of philanthropic and community funding for small nonprofits.

Nonprofit Administrative Capacity

The administrative capacity is the infrastructure that advances the values and goals of the organization and its programs.

Local Need

According to the FHSP's 2018 Nonprofit Assessment Report, the approximately 82% of Pinellas nonprofits have assets of less than \$10,000.

Why is Capacity Important?

Supporting Small Nonprofits is an Equity Issue

Investment in administrative and operational support for the organizations closest to systemic issues can help address economic and community development inequities.

Racial Disparities in Nonprofit Revenues and Assets

< 24%

Revenue of Black-led nonprofit organizations was 24% smaller than white nonprofit organizations.

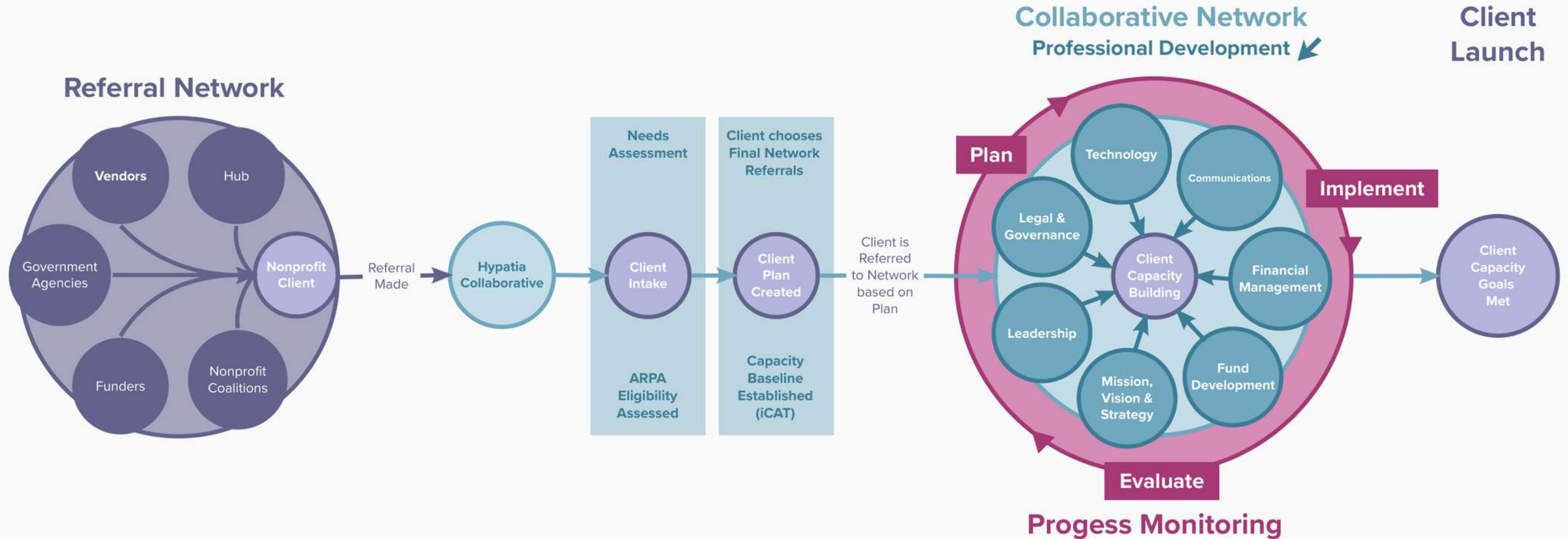
< 76%

Black-led organizations had 76% less unrestricted assets than their white counterparts.

Access to unrestricted funds is especially important given the **reduction** in household donations to nonprofits' unrestricted funds.
